Truth is a powerful virtue of the kingdom of God. Jesus called Himself, "the Truth." John 14:6 NKJV "Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me."

Peter called the gospel the "Way of truth." 2 Peter 2:2 NKJV "And many will follow their destructive ways, because of whom the way of truth will be blasphemed."

Jesus said the Father was seeking a new breed of worshippers. John 4:23 NKJV "But the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for the Father is seeking such to worship Him."
