Warm Up

What was something that you stuck with because it was very important to you?

Deuteronomy 9: 18-20, Deuteronomy 9: 24-29, Exodus 28:29, 1 Peter 2:9, Ezekiel 22: 29-30, 1 John 5: 14, 15, Romans 8:14, James 5:16b-18, Acts 12:1-11

Message Recap

As followers of Christ, we are called to be intercessors.

1. We need to bring people/situations before the Lord, perhaps for prolonged periods of time.
2. As Christ followers, we are to bring before the Lord the names of people that God places on our hearts to pray for.
3. God is looking for His people to stand in the gap, that things might be changed. Who or what situation is God calling you to pray for?
4. We need to pray for His will as led by His Spirit.
5. God does powerful things in His way and in His time in answer to prayers led by His Spirit.

Questions for discussion

1. What are some things that are happening in our world that need prayer?
2. What people in your life need prayer?
3. Who or what situation is God calling you to pray for?
4. What promises from Scripture can you use to help you pray?

Application

After you ask God as to what situation or person He wants you to pray for, pay attention to what situation or person that keeps coming to mind. Let that be your prayer assignment.
