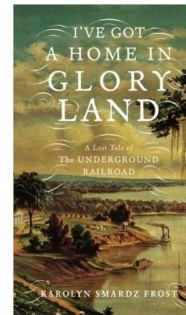

- * when peeling carrots, potatoes etc or any messy food products use a couple of pages of newspaper to wrap them in before depositing in the bin.



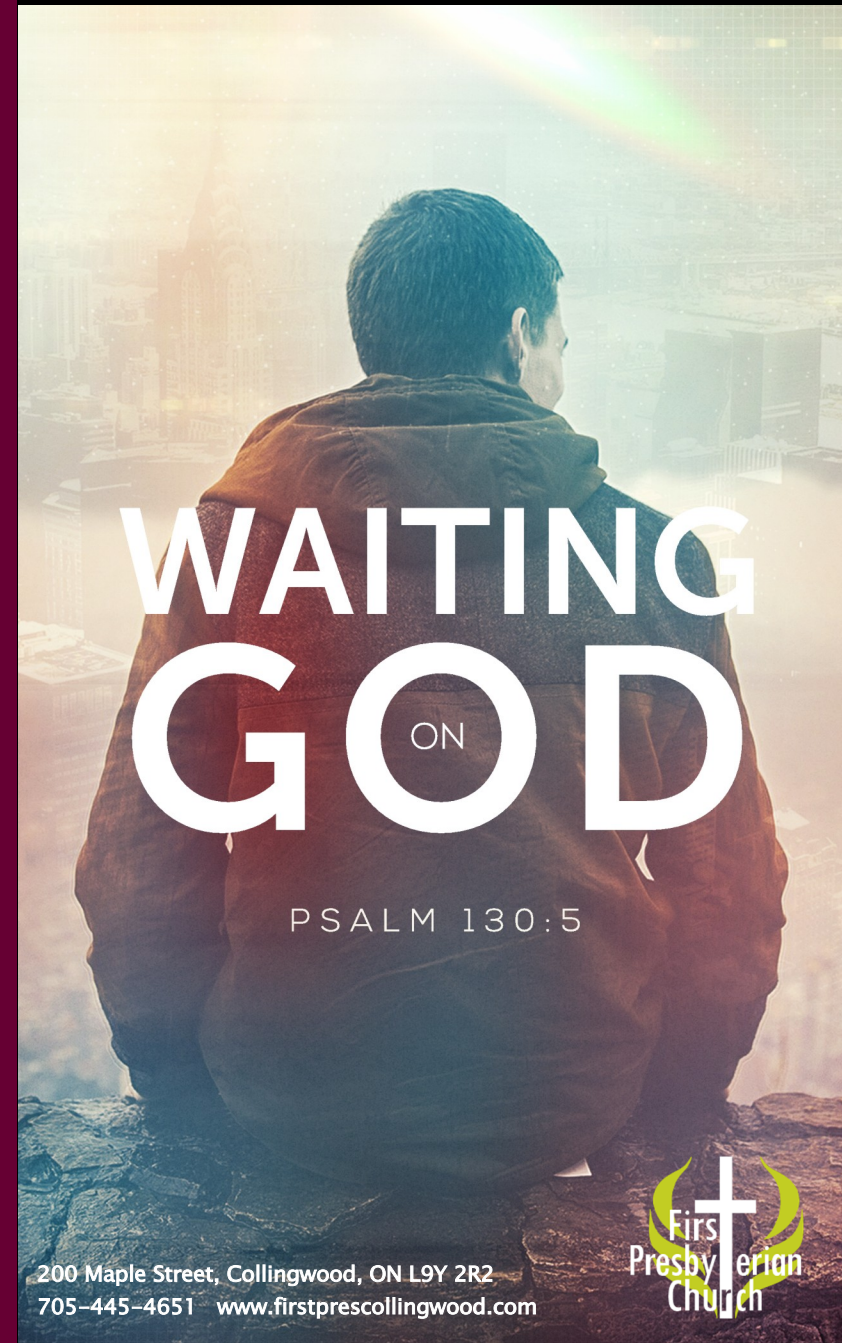
