### **Discussion Questions**

1. Are there areas of your life in which you are a control freak? Describe what that looks like for you. Why do you think it is so hard for people to give up control of certain aspects of their lives? What is the risk?
2. Read Luke 2:8-20 together. What are some of the reasons why the shepherds were so afraid?
3. In verses 11-12, the angel's address the shepherds. The 3 titles they use for Jesus are: Saviour, Christ, and Lord. What does each of these titles mean? Why would someone be afraid of allowing someone else to be their Saviour? Christ? Lord? In what ways and in which areas of your life do you find it challenging to submit to Jesus as Saviour, Christ or Lord?
4. Examine the response of the shepherds to the angelic message. What do they do? What can we learn from them?
5. What was Mary's reaction to everything that had gone on (her pregnancy, the birth of Jesus and the message from the shepherds)? What can we learn from Mary about how we should think about and receive what God is doing in our lives?
