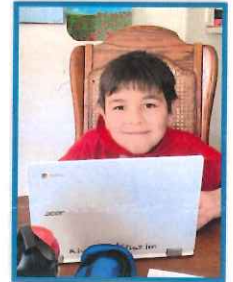
Greetings once again from the Naknakim Family!

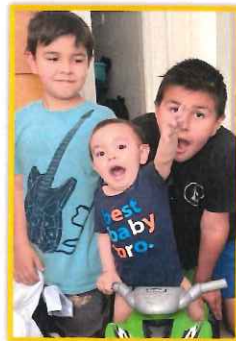
