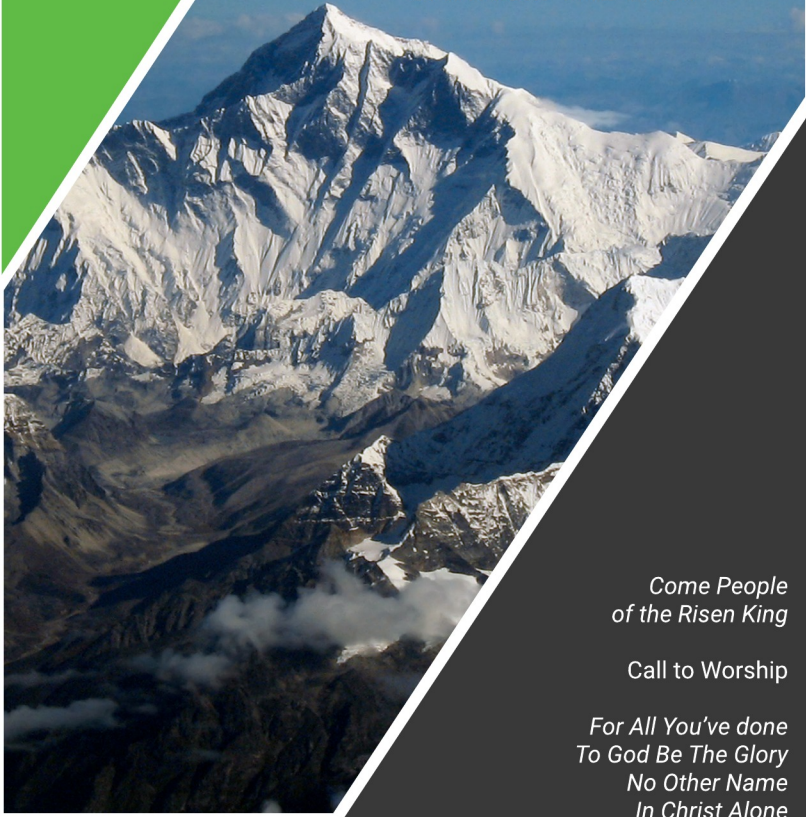

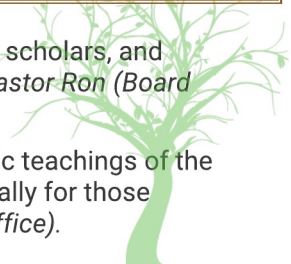
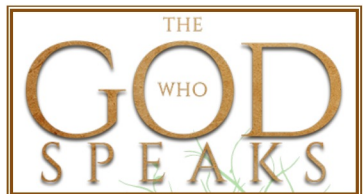
Adult Bible Class have resumed.
