A note before we begin...

Thank you for making space and taking the time to worship with us today. This guide is intended to be a framework for full participation in worship from the comfort of your own home.

Use as much or as little of the material as you'd like, but we do encourage you to step in and try something new. Read aloud, sing along, clap your hands, or simply invite God to meet you where you're at. Every journey begins with a step, and if you let Him, Jesus will faithfully lead you on an incomparable path of grace, mercy and love. One step at a time!

If you have younger worshipers with you, we encourage you to involve them in all aspects of this time of worship. Your full participation will inspire them to jump in too, and their participation may just inspire you right back!

If you plan to tune into our video teaching at the same time as others in our community (recommended) then you will want to begin your worship at home time at around **9:45 am**, as the chat opens at **10:15am** and the Sermon Stream will begins at **10:30am**.

Before you start, we suggest that you skim through this Worship at Home Guide in advance, and set up your computer or phone with the link for our broadcast, easily found on our website, **victoriaalliance.ca**.

ENTERING WORSHIP

CALL TO WORSHIP

If you have one available and feel safe doing so, light a candle and say these words aloud:

"We Light this candle to remind us that Jesus is the Light of the World, and He is with us always."

PRAISE & ADORATION

- Sing an a cappella hymn (suggestion: Blessed Assurance
- Take a moment to consider the beauty of God's character Take as much time as you need to complete the following sentence: God, I praise You for You are ______.
 Repeat as many times as you like.
- Sing a song of praise along with <u>VAC Spotify Playlist D</u>: Suggestions:
 - o Today is the Day
 - o Our God
 - o In Christ Alone
- Look around where you are right now. What do you see tha sparks a memory for you? Take a moment to bring that memory before God and give thanks for how God has used that experience to form you.

PRAYERS OF THE PEOPLE

As you spend time with God in prayer, consider lifting before God's care: those who are ill, injured, or in pain; those who are ir need of resources or assistance for day to day living; those who God brings to mind as you wait in prayer.

Join others in this prayer: (from Faith and worship)
For all whose day starts with anxiety, as they leave the security of home worrying about the risk of infection; particularly those whose health or age classifies them as vulnerable. Loving God, be close, keep them safe, along with all whose tasks today includes the care of frail and elderly. And for all of us, grant wisdom to make sensible choices, not just for ourselves, but for everybody.
