### Training modules available include:


- Reading Scripture & Liturgy in Public

- Spiritual Disciplines & Practices


Questions relating to on-site course delivery for groups or for the S.H.A.P.E. discernment & spiritual gifts program should be directed to the Warden of Layreaders.
