Seeing God Clearly

Isaiah 6:1 NLT

[1] It was in the year King Uzziah died that I **saw** the **Lord**. He was **sitting** on a lofty **throne**, and the train of his **robe filled** the **Temple**.

Opening Prayer

Open my eyes to see the wonderful truths in your instructions. (Psalms 119:18).

What you see is always determined by where you look and how you look to something.

When your spiritual vision improves, your life also improves.

Vision is always determine by frame and focus

- Frame: is what you put in the picture
- Focus: is paying attention in what you want to see in that picture

Isaiah 20/20 Vision as clear and perfect:

- 1. Saw the **LORD**
- 2. Seated on the Throne
- 3. His **Robe** filled the Temple
- 1. Seeing the Lord gives a sense of **Security** (problem solving, encouragement) **Psalms 16:11** You make known to me the path of life; in your presence there is fullness of joy; at your right hand are pleasures forevermore.
- 2. Seeing the Throne of God gives: a sense of **Justice** (Judgement, condemnation) **2 Corinthians 5: 10** For we must all stand before Christ to be judged. We will each receive whatever we deserve for the good or evil we have done in this earthly body.
- 3. Seeing the Royal Robe of God gives a sense of **Righteousness** (holiness, the Glory of God)

Isaiah 61:10 I am overwhelmed with joy in the Lord my God! For he has dressed me with the clothing of salvation and draped me in a robe of righteousness. I am like a bridegroom dressed for his wedding or a bride with her jewels.

 - Your sense of insecurity is a sign of not seeing God Cleary
 - Your sense of trying to justify yourself is a sign of not understanding God's Throne
 - Your sense of condemning others or yourself is a sign of not understanding God's Robe of righteousness
 - You cannot explain what has come upon you because you cannot comprehend the love of God
 - You always see things unclear and challenging to tell, and sometimes you see your fellow men like threes, and that is the reason why you are not sensitive to their needs.

Jesus Restores Sight to a Blind Man

Mark 8: 22-26

When they arrived at Bethsaida, some people brought a blind man to Jesus, and they begged him to touch the man and heal him. Jesus took the blind man by the hand and led him out of the village. Then, spitting on the man's eyes, he laid his hands on him and asked, "Can you see anything now?"

The man looked around. "Yes," he said, "I see people, but I can't see them very clearly. They look like trees walking around."

Then Jesus placed his hands on the man's eyes again, and his eyes were opened. His sight was completely restored, and he could see everything clearly.

The restoration of your sight help you:

- 1. To be familiar with your surrounding
- 2. To know where you must go from now and on
- 3. To allow you to be aware of any trap of the wicked ones
- 4. To see what others cannot see
- 5. To know that God is in control (**Security** (problem solving, encouragement); **Justice** (Judgement, condemnation); **Righteousness** (holiness, glory of God)





Verse 26 says that Jesus sent him away, saying, "Don't go back into the village on your way home."

As Isaiah and the blind man had a clear vision that led them to a new mission and mandate: you are you;

- Jesus is telling you tonight, do not go back into the village on your way home...
 In other words, don't go back to your old life.
- When Jesus saves us, He gives us new direction and instruction.

Prayer points:

- 1. Thank God for His gift of vision and dreams
- 2. Holy Spirit, make my spiritual visions clear in Jesus' name
- 3. Every power making me to forget my dream be arrested in Jesus' name
- 4. Lord, upgrade my spiritual gifts to be sensitive to your signals at all times.
- 5. Evil grip on my vision and dream be broken
- 6. Let every veil covering my spiritual eyes catch fire
- 7. My Lord, open my eyes to know the secret about my home, marriage, health and business according to your word in Jeremiah 33: 3 in Jesus' name
