



## “Time to check on your Spiritual Health”

### **Isaiah 55: 1-3 The Water for the Thirsty**

*“Come, all you who are thirsty, come to the waters; and you who have no money, come, buy and eat! Come, buy wine and milk without money and without cost. 2. Why spend money on what is not bread, and your labor on what does not satisfy? Listen, listen to me, and eat what is good, and you will delight in the richest of fare. 3. Give ear and come to me; listen, that you may live. I will make an everlasting covenant with you, my faithful love promised to David.*

**When you read Chapter 53 of the book of Isaiah, there is a great proclamation of the great price that was paid at Calvary. *Isaiah 53: 4-5* “Yet it was our weaknesses he carried; it was our sorrows that weighed him down. And we thought his troubles were a punishment from God, a punishment for his own sins! But he was pierced for our rebellion, crushed for our sins.**

**and Chapter 54 proclaims the coming grand and glorious Kingdom Age, now the inhabitants of the world are invited to come and partake of the One Who guarantees entrance into that Kingdom. *Verse 10 of Isaiah 43* says “Though the mountains be shaken and the hills be removed, yet my unfailing love for you will not be shaken nor my covenant of peace be removed,” says the Lord, who has compassion on you.**

Three times in this one Passage the word “come” is used, referring to Rev. 22:17. it is ***Revelation 22:17-*** *The Spirit and the bride say, “Come!” And let the one who hears say, “Come!” Let the one who is thirsty come; and let the one who wishes take the free gift of the water of life.*

The triple invitation corresponds to the Trinity: “God the Father,” “God the Son,” and “God the Holy Spirit.” **All are participants in the great Salvation Plan.**

**The four items of purchase are water, bread, wine, and milk.”** This explains and expresses the abundance of Grace in the Saviour, as exhibited in the four Gospels.

**The word “buy” is used, and yet the purchase price is not “money.”** Therefore, **the price that is demanded is the heart of man! *Rom. 10:9-10* - If you declare with your mouth, “Jesus is Lord,” and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. 10 For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess your faith and are saved}.**

**Two classes are invited by God: Everyone that is thirsty and He that has no money.**

- God is calling us to come to the waters, and he that had no money; come to buy, and eat;
- Come, buy wine and milk without money and without price. **Four "come's" to the thirsty and poor:**

1. Come to the waters (Isa. 54:1).
2. Come, buy, and eat.

3. Come, buy wine and milk without money and without price.
4. Come unto Me (Isa. 54:3).

### Four things offered by God which does require spiritual currencies

#### 1. Waters (Isa. 54:1):

- a. Of salvation (Isa. 12:3)
- b. Of everlasting life (John. 4:14; Revelation 7:16;
- c. Of Purification by the Word (Ephesians 5:26)
- d. Of satisfaction (Isaiah 32:2; 44:3)
- e. Of growth, fruitfulness, and success (Ps. 1:3; Jeremiah 17:5-8)
- f. Of Peace (Ps. 23:2)
- g. Of spiritual power (Jn. 7:37-39)

2. **Wine (Isa. 55:1).** Figurative of the blood of Jesus Christ by which we have forgiveness of sins - *Mt. 26:27-28 - 27 Then he took a cup, and when he had given thanks, he gave it to them, saying, "Drink from it, all of you. 28 This is my blood of the[a] covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins.*

3. **Milk (Isa. 55:10).** Figurative of the simplicity of truth - **1Cor. 3:2** - *I gave you milk, not solid food, for you were not yet ready for it. Indeed, you are still not ready. 1Pet. 2:2 Like newborn babies, crave pure spiritual milk, so that by it you may grow up in your salvation,*

#### 4. Bread (Isa. 55:2):

- a. Of life (Jn. 6:35-58)
- b. Of sincerity and truth (1Cor. 5:8)
- c. Of healing (Mt. 15:26)
- d. Of the broken body of Christ by which we receive healing (Mt. 26:26-29)

The waters, wine, milk, bread, and other benefits here must be understood as pertaining to spiritual things instead of natural and material, for they are the only things that can be bought without money. Furthermore, **the invitation is from God who is not in the business of selling material things; but He does have the blessings pictured figuratively by these terms.** The cry of the first verse is a common one in the East where water, wine, and milk are sold.

*Verse 2 states Why spend money on what is not bread, and your labor on what does not satisfy? Listen, listen to me, and eat what is good, and you will delight in the richest of fare. 3. Give ear and come to me; listen, that you may live. I will make an everlasting covenant with you, my faithful love promised to David.*

**What satisfies Man?** Men are constantly spending money and selling their lives for things that aren't necessary or beneficial in daily life - things that don't satisfy. **The immortal mind**

**of man can only be satisfied with the immortal God** - not with wealth, pleasure, greatness, and honour. No man, having lusted for these things, has ever been satisfied after receiving them to the full. They have proved to be vanity and vexation of spirit, pacifying for the moment, then leaving the heart with an aching void and a consciousness that man was made for higher and nobler things.

Where are you buying your water to quench your thirst of salvation?-  
salvation from wrong sources?

### **Why using false currency to purchase the Spiritual food?**

1. Waters of **salvation**
2. Wine - figurative of the blood of Jesus Christ by which we have **forgiveness of sins**
3. Milk - figurative of the simplicity of **truth**
4. Bread of life (Jn. 6:35-58) - the broken body of Christ by which we receive **healing**

The waters, wine, milk, bread, and other benefits here must be understood as pertaining to spiritual things instead of natural and material, for they are the only things that can be bought without money.

Let's accept the Spirit's invitation through the prophet knowing that it will bring a full satisfaction.

**It is time for us to check on our Spiritual Health, using Spiritual currency to get what is needed for our Spiritual Growth:**

1. **The Water of Salvation that bring everlasting life**, purification, satisfaction, growth, fruitfulness and success **is free** - don't let anyone ask you for money or buy it with corrupted currencies.
2. **The Wine of Forgiveness of sins, which is the blood of Jesus Christ is free** - don't let anyone ask you for money or buy it with corrupted currencies.
3. **The Milk of Truth, which is the word of God is free** - don't let anyone ask you for money or buy it with corrupted currencies.
4. **The Bread of Healing, which is the broken body of Christ is free** - don't let anyone ask you for money or buy it with corrupted currencies.
