Romans reveals the wisdom and prudence of God in his motions to conquer sin and death.

Romans 5:14-16 Nevertheless death reigned from Adam to Moses, even over them that had not sinned after the similitude of Adam's transgression, who is the figure of him that was to come. 15 But not as the offence, so also is the free gift. For if through the offence of one many be dead, much more the grace of God, and the gift by grace, which is by one man, Jesus Christ, hath abounded unto many. 16 And not as it was by one that sinned, so is the gift: for the judgment was by one to condemnation, but the free gift is of many offences unto justification.

God's wisdom and prudence has caused grace to abound over sin.

***Romans 5:20-21** Moreover the law entered, that the offence might **abound**. But where sin **abounded**, **grace did much more abound**: 21 That as sin hath reigned unto death, even so might grace reign through righteousness unto eternal life by Jesus Christ our Lord.*

Colossians 2:14-15 *Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross; 15 And having **spoiled principalities and powers**, he made a shew of them openly, triumphing over them in it.*

The Apostle James



James 1:5 If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him.

This is very practical as God's wisdom and prudence is available in the word, through his Spirit and in the church.

1 Corinthians 1:18-21 *For the preaching of the cross is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us which are saved it is the power of God. 19 For it is written, I will destroy the wisdom of the wise, and will bring to nothing the understanding of the prudent. 20 Where is the wise? where is the scribe? where is the disputer of this world? hath not God made foolish the wisdom of this world? 21 For after that in the wisdom of God the world by wisdom knew not God, it pleased God by the foolishness of preaching to save them that believe.*

6. He has made known unto us the mystery of his will. *Ephesians 1:9-12*

Ephesians 1:9-12 Having made known unto us **the mystery of his will**, according to his good pleasure which he hath purposed in himself: 10 That in the **dispensation of the fulness of times he might gather together in one all things in Christ, both which are in heaven, and which are on earth; even in him**: 11 In whom also we have obtained an **inheritance**, being predestinated according to the purpose of him who worketh all things after the counsel of his own will: 12 That we should be to the praise of his glory, who first trusted in Christ.

God not only shares that we are predestined in *Ephesians 1:5* but in *Ephesians 1:9-11* God shares why we are predestined!


Acts 3:19 Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord;

1 Corinthians 15:27-28 *For he hath put all things under his feet. But when he saith all things are put under him, it is manifest that he is excepted, which did put all things under him. 28 And when all things shall be subdued unto him, then shall the Son also himself be subject unto him that put all things under him, that God may be all in all.*
