 - 3. He has made us accepted in the beloved. *Ephesians 1:6*

Ephesians 1:6 To the praise of the glory of his grace, wherein he hath made us accepted in the **beloved**. [Last week we learned that in this instance the word beloved is referring to Jesus Christ. We studied out the various uses in the bible and showed how context revealed we are accepted in Christ.]

4. He has <u>redeemed</u> us. **Ephesians 1:7**
