

Small group questions for further reflection:

Memorial: How do many little cups and many little crackers distort the visual story of the Lord's Supper?

Covenant: The prophet Jeremiah prophesied that the people of the New Covenant would possess "singleness of heart and action." (Jer. 32:39). As believers of the New Covenant, how should this look in our Christian communities?

Community: When we are in communion with Jesus, how should that affect our communion with our fellow believers?

Proclamation of the Gospel: What makes us worthy to participate in the Lord's Supper?
How do believers "preach Christ crucified" with their actions?

Spiritual Nourishment: Jesus is not literally in the bread and the wine, so how are believers spiritually nourished at the Lord's Supper?

Anticipation: What do you anticipate the most about Christ's second return?
