BAC AT HOME SERMON GUIDE

"SELF-RIGHTEOUSNESS AND THE JUSTICE OF GOD" ROMANS 2:1-29

- → Pray for the Holy Spirit to open your eyes and guide you in all truth (John 16:13-16) as you reflect on his Word, especially in this week's difficult passage
- → Read Romans 2:1-11 aloud
- → When you consider the wrath of God, what emotions does that stir up in you? How do you understand the relationship between God's wrath and His love? What are the implications of God's wrath and love on your life?
- → How have you sought to maintain control over your life through external behaviour? What does it reveal about what is most important to you (ie does it reveal any idols of your heart)? In what ways have you passed judgment on others but held on to your own unrepentance?
- → In what ways do you struggle with obeying in order to get certain blessings or favour from God (obeying out of obligation) rather than obeying because of what Jesus did for you in his life, death and resurrection (obeying out of gratitude)?
- → What is God saying to you in this Word, in the sermon, and in your walk with Him this week?
- → What is God telling you to do? How can we be part of helping you obey?
- → If you are discussing these questions as a Group, pray for one another in the specific ways the Holy Spirit is speaking truth into your lives.
