

## WEEK 1-1 Timothy: Mentor Me Series - Life Group Questions

- 1. Icebreaker Question: What is something you are enjoying about this season?
- 2. What was the occasion for Paul's letter to Timothy? (Refer to 1 Tim. 1:3, 5-6, 3:14-15)
- 3. Read 1 Timothy 1:1-11 together (Bonus Reading Options: 1 Tim. 4:1-5 & 6:1-10)
- 4. What do you think it was like for Christians living in the church in Ephesus at that time? (Or for Timothy leading that church?)
- 5. The series theme for the 1 Timothy series is "Mentor Me" based on the Apostle Paul's mentoring of Timothy & our church's call to be in mentoring & discipling relationships and groups this fall. Who is a mentor you've had in your life? What impact did they have on your life?
- 6. Would you benefit from being a partner of a mentoring relationship? Is there anything holding you back?
- 7. We identified a first mentoring lesson from the Apostle Paul as "warning me" of possible dangers. Share a story of how you've been warned in your life. Was it helpful or unhelpful?
- 8. Of the 10 warnings that we identified from the Apostle Paul's mentoring, which one did you most need to hear?
- 9. What is a way the group can pray for you?

## 10 Warnings from the Apostle Paul – mentioned in the sermon

- 1. Be vigilant against letting false teaching in (1:3)
- 2. Watch you don't waste your time in meaningless speculation (1:4)
- 3. Be careful you don't miss the main thing in life (1:5-6)
- 4. Don't disregard God's instructions (1:8-11)
- 5. Watch out that you don't fall for the devil's lies (4:1)
- 6. Protect your conscience (4:2)
- 7. Don't give up on marriage (4:3)
- 8. Don't stop giving thanks for God's good creation (4:3-5)
- 9. Be careful to show full respect for those in authority (6:1)
- 10. Guard your heart from the love of money (6:9-10)

Summary: Warn me about getting off track with God

**Going Deeper: Read Exodus 20; 21:15ff &** Lev 18:22 and 20:13 and see how they interconnect with the Apostle Paul's warning to not disregard God's instructions in 1 Tim. 1:8-11

**Group Challenge:** Get creative & go deeper – how can you encourage one another to be reading, studying and praying through the book of 1 Timothy?
