Reverend Ormand Lavenne died on Friday, September 18, 2020 in Calgary, Alberta at age 87 years after suffering a severe blood infection. He did his best to stay with us as long as possible. Ormand was an ordained United Church of Canada minister for 60 years; graduating from the University of Alberta with Bachelors of Arts and Divinity degrees. 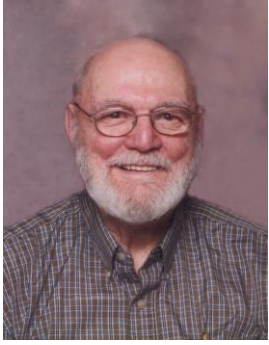
