#### The Pikangikum Water Project.

On the Pikangikum First Nation Reserve, north of Ke-  
nora, ON, 95% of the homes do not have running wa-  
ter or waste water management. Residents collect  
their daily water from cisterns throughout the com-  
munity and share dilapidated outhouse with their  
neighbours. The goal of the Pikangikum Working  
Group is to provide a source of potable drinking wa-  
ter by equipping each home with a cistern and a  
wastewater holding tank, as well as the necessary fix-  
tures and fittings.
