The Pikangikum Water Project.

On the Pikangikum First Nation Reserve, north of Kenora, ON, 95% of the homes do not have running water or waste water management. Residents collect their daily water from cisterns throughout the community and share dilapidated outhouse with their neighbours. The goal of the Pikangikum Working Group is to provide a source of potable drinking water by equipping each home with a cistern and a wastewater holding tank, as well as the necessary fixtures and fittings.
