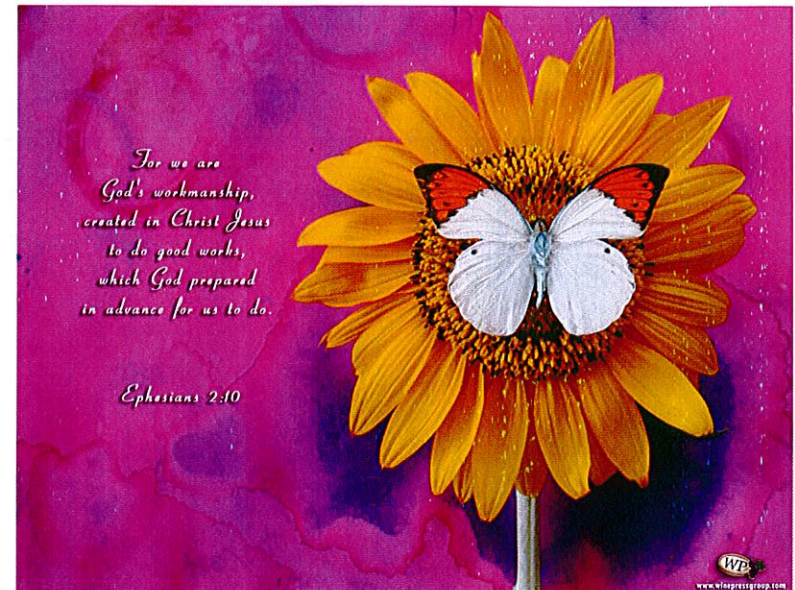

What did you take home from Sunday's sermon?

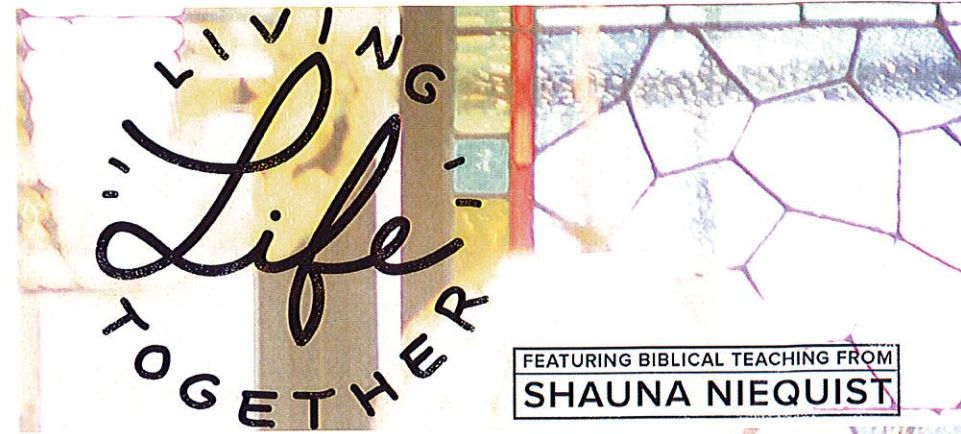
Someone read Ephesians 2:1-10

Share some different areas you see our world chasing after sin. What desires do we still chase after? Who do we know in our own lives that is still caught in sin and separated from God? Spend some time praying for those people that God would open their eyes and make them alive by His powerful grace.

How has God's grace impacted your life? How does God's grace impact your worship and your relationship with Him? Has God's grace influenced the way you treat others with grace? Why is it so important that our salvation hinge in grace and nothing else?

Verse 7 refers to what God's purpose is in all of this grace. He is bringing glory to Himself by showing mercy and grace. Why does God desire to receive glory and praise? How is it challenging for people to worship a God whose focus is Himself? How do we often steal the focus of life and put it on ourselves? If you had the chance to ask God one question about life what would it be and why?

We are God's handiwork and He has work prepared for us. What good works has God been preparing you for? How has God used you in the past? What work is God using you in right now in your life? Spend some time praying for each other and the work God is using you in.
