Message: **God is the Redeemer: Exodus 4:29-6:8**

Reflection Questions:

Moses deals with failure and disappointment. God reveals that He is a redeemer who will call the Israelites from slavery to sonship.

1. Redemption is from slavery (6:6)

- Pharaoh is defiant (5:2).
- God told Moses that Pharaoh would not listen (3:19-20)
- Moses has to learn that Redemption is above his pay grade (6:1)

Do you feel that you can trust God?

Are you dependant on Him?

2. Redemption is for covenant relationship with God (6:7)

- The Israelites have a slave mindset (5:15)
- God calls Israel his "firstborn son" (4:22)
- Covenant moves us from slavery to sonship (6:7)
- Covenant has narrative shaping power

Do you relate to God as a covenantal Father?

Has His relationship left a mark on your soul?
