The 2st Migration: To an Inward Protection

- Severe pressures on religious institutes
- Complex secular milieu
- Society "spiritual but not religious"
- Loss of membership and finances
- Sexual orientation removed as barrier
- Migrated away from earlier zeal
- Focused on survival
- Membership declining
- Top-heavy church governance


The 3d Migration: A New Governance






appendix iii MORE ON BELIEFS

- · CONCEPTUAL (NOTIONAL) BELIEFS -
- beliefs that something exists
- RELATIONAL BELIEFS:
 - demand statements of conceptual beliefs as proof of loyalty or requirement for belonging.
 - object of belief provides rewards and punishments based on conceptual beliefs

"We are caught between relational and conceptual belief, between personal loyalty to a community and personal intellectual integrity." We say:

"Straining out gnats while swallowing camels."

The Predicament of Belief

Philip Clayton and Steven Knapp

- Provides an overview of recent debates in science, philosophy, and religion
- Summarises academic debates in readable, nontechnical language
- Avoids rhetoric and extremist language, seeking reasonable answers in the midst of contentious debates
- Explores skeptical arguments and grounds for doubt
- Advocates a "minimalist" form of Christian belief for the 21st century

SIX LEVELS OF BELIEF

Can Christianity of the future convene around something other than a list of conceptual beliefs?

McLaren's Fourfold Alternative to the Centrality of Conceptual Beliefs



LEG 1: A STORY

CONVENTIONAL VERSION

CONTEMPORARY VERSION

- perfect creation
- the fall
- human history in a sinful, damned world
- salvation
- perfect redemption in heaven
- perfect damnation in hell

- Jesus and news of the kingdom of God (the table top)
- evidential approach to revelation - other ways of knowing
- story of God, present with creation, present to every event in deep solidarity

These stories:

- move from exclusivity to inclusivity
- lead from violence to peace

Engaged with the story in an integral or literary way of reading the Bible.



1 Kings: 18 to Luke 9: 53-55

Elijah, Baal and fire from God

"Now when his disciples James and John saw this, they said, "Lord, do you want us to call fire to come down from heaven and consume them?" But Jesus turned and rebuked them, and they went on to another village."

LEG 2: SAINTS Heroes of Faith & Living Elders

- "For the saint, the meaning of life is love... Life (has) a purpose (which is) love...
- Saints play a prominent role in Christian history
 - moral authority, Christlike character, authentic spirituality and self-giving service
 - Thomas Aquinas, Francis of Assisi, Patrick, Teresa of Avila
 - "(we) consider the outcome of their way of life and imitate their faith" Hebrews 13:7
 - Elders are tried and tested people whose words are backed up by their way of life and...
 challenge us to grow in faith, hope and love.

LEG 3: PRACTICE "SHARED RITUALS, HABITS AND BEHAVIOURS BY WHICH WE BOND TO MEANING AND JOY"

McLaren says: "When faith is completely replaced by creed, worship by discipline, love by habit; when the crisis of today is ignored because of the splendour of the past; when faith becomes an heirloom rather than a living fountain; when religion speaks only in the name of authority rather than with the voice of compassion — its message becomes meaningless."

LEG 4: A VISION OF THE FUTURE

"USING THE BIBLE TO DEEPEN OUR MORAL IMAGINATION SO WE CAN, WITH THE SPIRIT'S GUIDANCE AND EMPOWERMENT, ENVISION AND CO-CREATE A DESIRABLE FUTURE."

- we will celebrate the meaning and joy of the loving way of life embodied by Jesus
- we will commune and be filled with the nonviolent, liberating Spirit of God embodied by Jesus
- we will organize people for mission so more and more of us can become embodiments of Christ in our world, working for the common good."

McLaren says: "This is the good news of great joy for all people — good news to believe in, good news to share, good news to launch a great spiritual migration"
