Reflection Questions:

- Ask yourself... Who do you have unresolved conflicts with? What is the root cause of each conflict? Then ask God... Who do I have unresolved conflicts with? What is the root cause of each conflict? Is there agreement between God and yourself?
- 2. Jesus' sacrifice has given us authority to live out God's call to master sin. Looking up to the face of Christ without fear of judgment demonstrates that mastery. Are you able to exercise your will and look up to Jesus?
- 3. The preservation of your way of life, or taking part in God's mission of reconciliation. What matters more to you, and why?
- 4. What are the ongoing conflicts that you know of, or that God has made known to you? Have you been idle or active in joining God's work of reconciliation in these conflicts?
