I. The Birth of Jesus

Luke 2:1-7

Waiting Wondering

#### A Census is Called

- \* Joseph takes Mary from Nazareth to Bethlehem (80 miles)
- \* A demanding journey for Mary in her final days of pregnancy



## No Room

- \* There's no room for them at the inn when they reach Bethlehem
- \* They find rest in a manger area (cave) and Mary gives birth to Jesus
- \* Born in a manger (3x v7,12,16)

Waiting Wondering

## A lonely Experience for Mary

- \* She wraps the child
- \* Jesus' identification with the poor, marginalized
- \* Born in a stable/ not a palace

# To the Shepherds

- \* The shepherds are terrified and the angel calms them – "Do not be afraid"
- \* Indeed the angel announces 'good news' of 'great joy' for all the people (v9) – this is happy news not fearful news

IV. The Participation of the Shepherds

Luke 2:15-20

Waiting Wondering

# They 'Go to See'

- \* Having received the angel's message the shepherds go to see what has happened (v15)
- \* They make a choice a brave and risky choice to leave the flock and go

Waitin#Wondering

#### The Shepherds' Response

Similar to the magi the shepherds demonstrate:

- i. Awareness tune into the angel
- ii. Receptivity respond positively to the message
- iii. Intentionality go to find the child

#### **Praising God**

- \* The shepherds go and return praising God (v20) demonstrating an open heart of faith
- \* They open up and say 'yes' to Jesus



\* Others benefit from the shepherd's message and participation (v18) - including Mary who treasures their words (v19)



# The Shepherds' Model of Faith

- i. Watch over their flock we also watch over others & ourselves
- ii. Risk they take the risk of faiththey walk in faith amidst life's challenges
- iii. Act not passive or apathetic they exhibit a zealous enthusiasm for God Watung Wondering
