A Study in Philippians

This morning we return one last time to Paul's letter to the Philippians. Our text today is Philippians 4:10-23, where Paul concludes with some personal words about contentment, fellowship and the all-sufficiency of God.

Philippians is a letter that speaks with fresh relevance to our world and lives today. Within these 4 chapters we find: Paul exploring the challenge of following Jesus in the face of opposition; the call to unity amidst diverse perspectives and agendas; the joy of Christ that no suffering can extinguish; and the life that is in Christ that death cannot defeat.
