Step 2 Ramoth Apartment Update

This season at Ramoth House brings excitement as we have been working hard to complete the renovations in apartment 3! We have also been working to develop life skills programs primarily for our moms within our Step Two program of care. Now that the renovations are completed, apartment 3, also known as the new Programming Hub, is ready to be used as a new and improved way of helping our moms discover their parenting potential. We have pre-developed programs like our baking program as well as newly developed programs like fitness and batch cooking that will be offered in our Programming Hub. Our moms will also have access to computers to use for schooling, accessing employment, online training, etc. and will continue to use our Step Two store. Our programs are mandatory for our Step Two clients but will also be available for Step One moms to join in voluntarily. The goal of these programs is to help our moms develop independence and transferrable skills that they can take beyond Ramoth House.
