Welcome Visitors

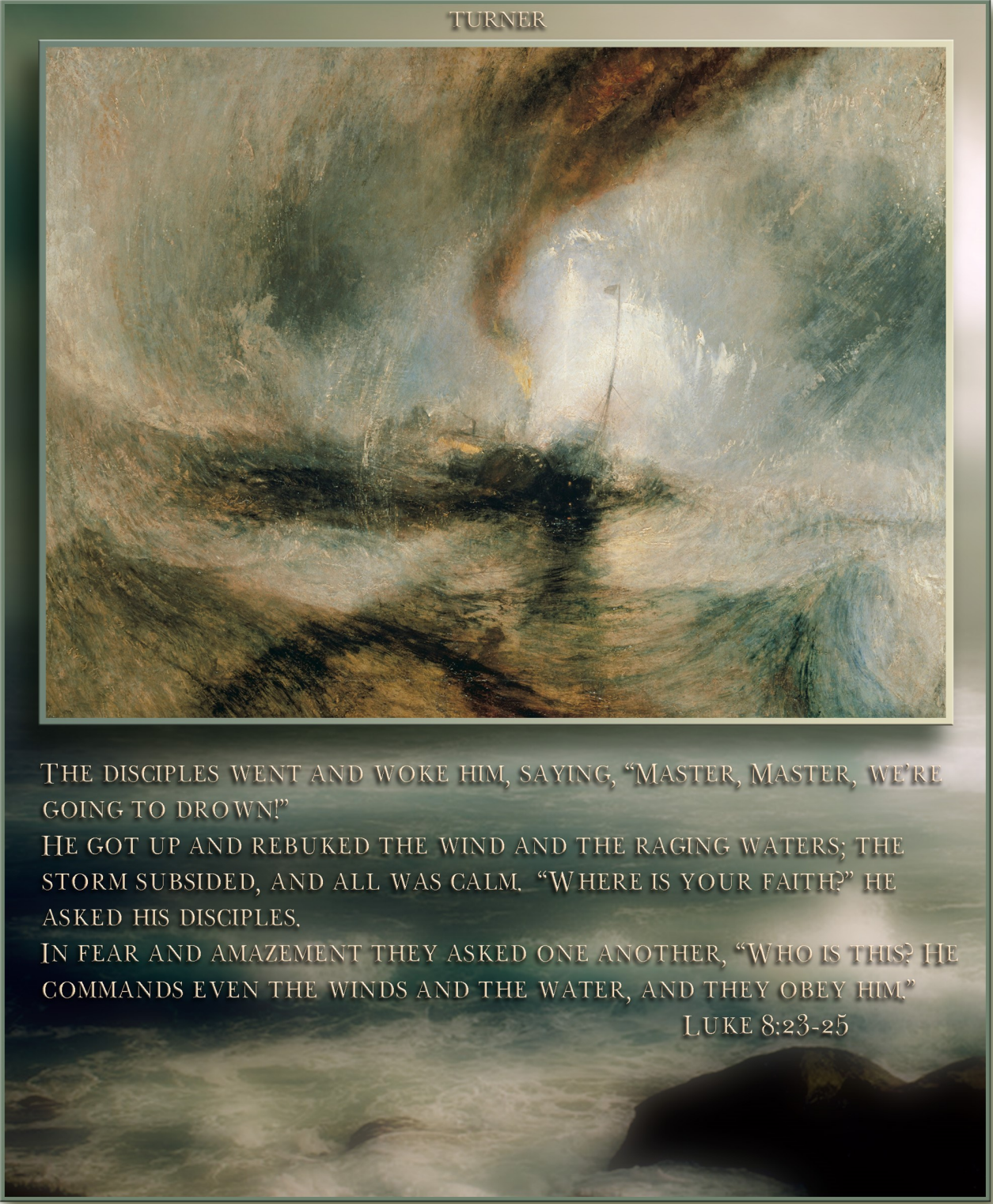
