Sermon Summary: June 09, 2019

Messy Church

- Unity in diversity is not easy, it's messy
- All along, God intended that the church would be a group of diverse people
- In Acts 2 we read about the formation of the first church (Acts 2:41-47)
 - We want this picture of church because it's tidy
 - However, this was not the church as it was intended to be. This was the church in its initial, immature, undeveloped infancy
 - It consisted entirely of like-minded Jews
 - 5 years later they hadn't diversified so God scattered them through a persecution
 - The church would have stayed tidy if it could, because that was easy. But God is calling her to messy diversity, which is never easy
- We need to focus on what unifies us, not what makes us different.
 - o We major on the majors, and minor on the minors
 - Instead of being in competition, we should be partnering with other organizations and churches
- The true picture of church is heaven, not Acts 2. (Rev 7:9-17)
