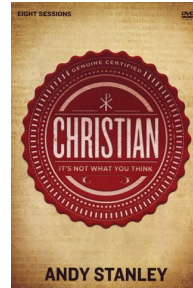
First Pres. Travelling Troupe (Ukulele)
