As the Christmas holidays approach we're reminded of many wonderful traditions—from Christmas cards, to family gatherings, and even candlelight church services. One impactful tradition our church has observed over the years is the Lottie Moon Christmas Offering, an annual offering collected by Christians all over the world to support international missions. The offering was named over 100 years ago in honor of Charlotte "Lottie" Moon, a Southern Baptist missionary to China who was instrumental in raising awareness and support for missions work. This offering is unique in that 100% of monies donated to it will go straight to missionaries serving where God has called them.



There are 47,530 churches cooperating within the Southern Baptist Convention, comprising a total membership of 14,525,579 people. If just 25% of Southern Baptists gave \$100 to the Lottie Moon Christmas Offering, we could raise nearly \$400 million. This offering will help missionaries get to the field, evangelize the lost, disciple new believers, form healthy churches, develop leadership, and then continue partnership with those churches while leaving them in the care of their new leaders.
