


QUESTIONS YOU MIGHT ASK



"Am I responsible for collecting the money?"



No, you are Not responsible for collecting the money. Turn your Pledge Forms in at the Registration table the day of the walk and Heartland Baptist Fellowship will collect the money through the mail. If sponsors insist on giving you money, please mark the "Paid Cash" or "Paid Check" box below their name, and turn in the funds collected with your Pledge Form. "How far is the walk?"



It is 4.4 miles, so people of all ages can participate. You simply ask your family and friends to sponsor you with a generous, one-time, tax-deductible gift for your participation in the walk, instead of sponsoring you per mile.



"What do I do if it rains?"



We will be walking rain or shine. Bring your umbrella and walk with us, or just bring the forms to us on the day of the Walk and walk on your own as soon as possible.

Thank you for being concerned about the problems that drugs, alcohol, and other addictive behaviors cause in our communities, and for being willing to help raise support for our Christ centered ministry, by using this form to get pledges. While there are other programs available that can help someone to become clean and sober, ONLY the truth can truly make them free (John 8:32).

Life Issues was formed in January 2011; since that time over 500 students have benefited from our program. Some come to us as referrals from the Cass County Drug Court or DUI Court, some hear about us through Heartland Baptist's jail ministry, and some are moms and dads seeking help for their children. Many come because they have talked to our leaders and other Life Issues students, and are seeking help for themselves or trying to help loved ones.

On **Saturday, September 3rd, 2016** Life Issues will be hosting our 4th annual 4.4 mile Recovery Walk and fundraiser, with three goals in mind::

- Raise money See listing of needs below.
- 2. Publicity Let the community know who we are and what we're doing to combat addiction.
- 3. Team work Let our leaders and students link arms with others for a common goal.

Addiction has been defined as a life dominating sin, so Life Issues focuses on imparting God's wisdom into people's hearts and teaching life skills to help break the cycle of sin and keep it from becoming generational. Life Issues is a structured recovery program, built upon biblical wisdom and caring accountability. Our team of volunteers exists to provide the tools needed to break the crushing impact of wounds that addictions and poor decisions have made. People who come to our meetings find acceptance and leave with hope.

Below are some tangible things that we provide to those who God brings our way; the pledges collected with this form will help to offset these expenses and the ongoing costs of our program:

- Benevolence fund: transportation, emergency housing, gas, food, etc.
- Counseling accountability, and rehabilitation services
- Monthly activities
- Part-time employee wages
- Outreach events
- Teaching materials and awards
- Supplies, publishing, and advertising
- Technical costs, i.e. computer equipment, cell phone, etc.
