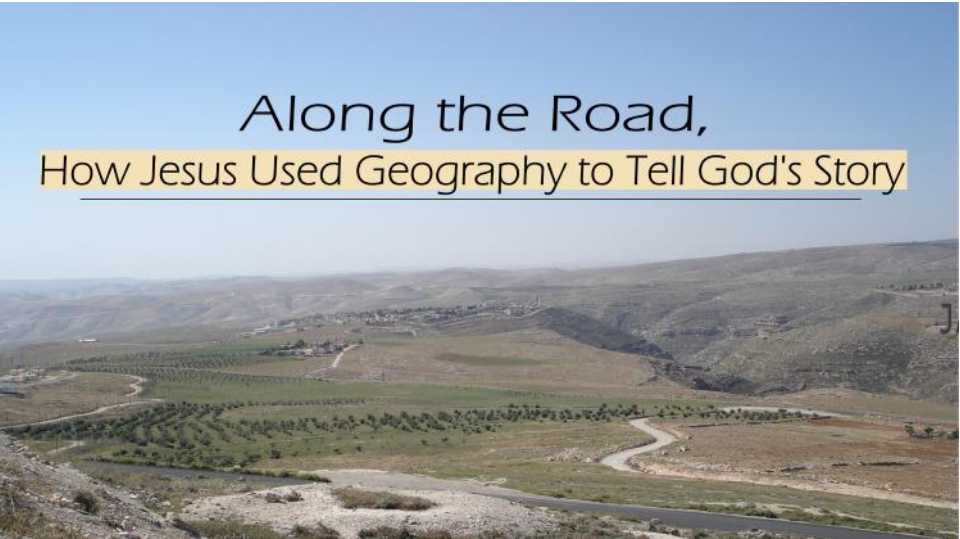

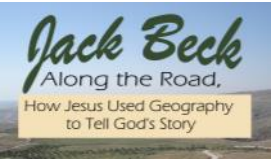


Today:
