(c) Pyrogy Supper – potential fundraiser for M&S

- It could be incorporated with "Pink Shirt Day" to promote the awareness of peace.
- The logo for Mission & Service is a rainbow coming out of the manger.
- Our church makes a commitment every year to send a certain \$\$\$ figure to Mission & Service.

(d) Ornaments

 As we get closer to Christmas, our children/youth could make ornaments that relate to the gifts from the Mission & Service gift-giving catalogue, and hang them on a special Mission & Service tree in the church foyer, or give to family/friends.

6. **NEW BUSINESS**

- Leila will ask Betty Warrington if she could take the services while Leila is away.

(d) Lodge & Long Term Care Services – Sunday July 9th

- Jen will be looking after getting someone to fill in over the summer and will let the committee know who will be playing for regular Sunday services.

(e) Summer Programming – through Coronation Presbytery

- It kind of competes with the VBS that is offered in Hanna every summer. Kids want to go where their friends are going (but they could bring their friends here too).
- We won't utilize this 'service' this year. But good to know it exists.

(f) **Upcoming Fall Church Programs/Services ??**

- The knitting circle is now done all the people that used to come are either deceased or in long-term care.
- The meditation group is now done there were only a few that were coming, and we haven't had anyone attending in a while.
- For Fall, are there any new programs that we could offer? Try to think of some things over the summer, and then we can brain storm in the Fall about this, to possibly offer more services.
