The Baptism of the Lord

A voice came from heaven, saying, "This is my beloved Son with whom I am well pleased.

Matthew 3:17

TODAY'S READINGS

First Reading: Isaiah 42:1-9 This passage reveals one of the earliest missional statements for the God's people; namely they are to bring 'light to the nations'. In our day, we carry on this powerful mission, as members of the baptised, light bearers for Jesus Christ.

Epistle: Acts 10:34-43 The Gospel of Jesus Christ has no boarders. This portion of the Acts of the Apostles (written by Luke), moves the audience of the gospel beyond the Jewish world. In this occasion, Peter is preaching to both Jews and Gentiles.

The Holy Gospel: St. Matthew 3:13-17 The passage from Matthew describes the baptism of Jesus by his cousin John the Baptist. It seems to reveal two things; the humility of Jesus to be baptized by John, and the revelation of Jesus ministry in hearing God's voice once the baptism took place.
