2 Message Introduction

Last week, we looked at who Jesus is from God's perspective. The Bible tells us that God said Jesus is His beloved Son. He is the Messiah, the promised Saviour of God. Today, let us look at who did Jesus think He was in the Bible?



3 Let's find out!

Watch this video: Who Did Jesus Think He Was?

- 1. Who did Jesus claim to be?
 - a) Jesus claimed to be the Messiah.
 - b) Jesus claimed to be the Son of God.
 - c) Jesus claimed to be the Son of Man.
- 2. After watching the video, does it conflict with what you learned last week? Who was Jesus to you last week? Did it change this week?

Jesus understood what was His role here on earth clearly. At different points of His ministry, He shared with the people around Him who He is. And when Jesus said that He is the Son of God, it means He and God have a really close relationship.

Why is knowing the relationship between God and Jesus important? The reason is because it helps us to understand God better. Jesus is the visible image of the invisible God.

4 what does the Bible Say?

Let us also look at what the Bible says:

- 1. Read Colossians 1:15-20
- 2. The Bible explicitly says that
 - He is the image of the invisible God. (v.15)
 - And through Him and for Him, all things were created. (v.16)
 - He is the head of the body, the church. (v.18)
 - Through Him to reconcile to Himself all things, making peace by the blood of His cross. (v.20)
 - This passage tells us that Jesus represents God and that He was there when everything started, and through Him we receive salvation.

Reflection:

- What do you think is the best way for God to reveal Himself?
- 2. What have you learned about God through the life of Jesus?

In the Old Testament, God remained as someone who was far away, someone who was impossible to be seen. But Jesus is the Son of God, when He came on earth, He was the manifestation and representation of God. Through Jesus, we are able to have a better understanding of God. Jesus lived out the teachings of God, He demonstrated the love of God, and most importantly we see the mercy and grace of God through Jesus.

Therefore, **the more we know about Jesus, the more about God we know.** And to answer the question of who Jesus thinks He is, we can come to the conclusion that He knows that He is the Son of God, He knows that He is the Messiah, and that He is the Son of Man. He knows His identity and what His identity meant to those around Him.
