I. BAPTISM IS IMPORTANT BECAUSE IT IS IMPERATIVE

**“Go therefore and make disciples of all nations,
baptizing them in the name of the Father and of
the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to
observe all that I have commanded you.”**

(Matthew 28:19-20)

OBEDIENCE AS A DISCIPLE
