Text: 1 Corinthians 3:16-17

## Verses for the Week:

1 Corinthians 3:16-17 - Don't you know that you yourselves are God's temple and that God's Spirit dwells in your midst? If anyone destroys God's temple, God will destroy that person; for God's temple is sacred, and you together are that temple.

Acts 17:24 - The God who made the world and everything in it—he is Lord of heaven and earth—does not live in shrines made by hands.

Leviticus 26:11- 13 - I will place my residence among you, and I will not reject you. I will walk among you and be your God, and you will be my people. I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, so that you would no longer be their slaves. I broke the bars of your yoke and enabled you to live in freedom.
