Read Ephesians 2:1-10

Read through the text again. What stands out or impacts you?



This past Sunday was Pentecost Sunday and it was noted how important the Spirit is in regards to our walk in Christ. How have you seen the Holy Spirit work in your life?

Paul lists three forces that pull us, lure us, and compel us in the wrong direction. What are these?

Paul counters this with "but God". What are some phrases he uses to describe God?

Which of the forces that Paul mentioned do you struggle with most?

What is God's attitude to those living in sin and what is He willing to do for those dead in sin?

What does it mean to be raised and seated with Christ?

This world seems to be spinning away from God and toward its own destruction. However, God's love has found a way from the despair of death to the joy of the gift of life in Christ. What are we called to do in the midst of this?

Verse 10 says: "For we are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do." As you listen to the Spirit's leading in your life what do you sense He is calling you to do?
