THE RELATION OF LAW AND GRACE IN SALVATION

There is a difference between the basis of salvation (grace) and the content of revelation

The law revealed grace

The purpose of the sacrifices

The law instituted a code of conduct that when broken led the offender to a face to face need to offer sacrifices for the forgiveness of sin

Sacrifices were an atonement as they contained the Christological message that there is a greater salvation coming
