**First Reading: Exodus 33:12-23** p.96

The text of Exodus 33:12-23 is the culmination of a series of new revelations of God's identity and names throughout the book of Exodus

**Epistle: 1 Thessalonians 1:1-10 p.1267** "I really can't say enough good about you!" So echoes Paul's sentiment at the beginning of Thessalonians.

**The Holy Gospel: Matthew 22:15-22** p.1061 This Sunday's text finds the Pharisees and Herodians setting a trap for Jesus, hoping he will answer their questions improperly and either lose favour with the public, or get in trouble with the Roman authorities. The larger issue is how we deal with this text in a contemporary world where, for some of us, our duties to God and country might seem to be at odds with one another.
