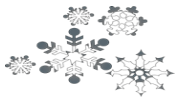

**Tuesday February 11 3:45 pm – 5:00pm**



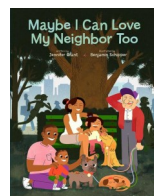
All ages are Welcome!
