SERMON QUESTIONS:

1. What did the Spirit teach you through the sermon on Sunday?
2. Has anyone ever dismissed your faith as foolish? How did you respond?
3. Pastor Barton said that there are only two types of people in the world. What are they and where do you lean?
4. "Religion is a crutch for humankind. It's for weak people who cannot think and act for themselves." How would you respond to that?
5. The argument that "Christians wish there was a God who could make them feel better and so they invented him" cuts both ways. How so?
6. Many people, including Christians, believe that Christianity makes one's life easier. Does it? Explain.
7. What stood out to you most from this sermon series?
