### Week 2 - Oct 11

Scripture: Luke 22:7,19-20

The Point: The New Covenant did not mean "new in addition to", but "new in place of".

Reflection Question: Have you ever been angry with God because of something a Christian said?

### Week 3 - Oct 18

Scripture: John 13:34

The Point: Do for others what Jesus has done for you.

Reflection Question: What are a few examples of doing for others what Jesus has done for you?

### Week 4 - Oct 25

Scripture: 1 John 4:18-19, Ephesians 4:22-24, 2:2-4

The Point: The Way will make you way different because you'll weigh things differently.

Reflection Question: How does all of this affect the way you read the Old Testament?

## SHORT, HELPFUL BLOG POST

Shepherding the emotions, changes, behavior, and attitudes of one kid for 18 years is incredibly difficult. And if you have multiple kids, it's even more difficult because you can't parent each kid the exact same way.

And, yet, in a sense, you can parent each kid the exact same way. Jesus made it clear that our one commandment in the context of the New Covenant is to do for others what has been done for us in the gospel. So how has God Fathered you? How does He treat you when you're in a bad mood? How does He respond to your mistakes? How has He shepherded you in the midst of your immaturity? And what would it look like to reflect that to your own kids?

God demonstrated ideal parenting when He sent His Son to die on the cross, and He continues to demonstrate it as He interacts with us now every day in Christ.

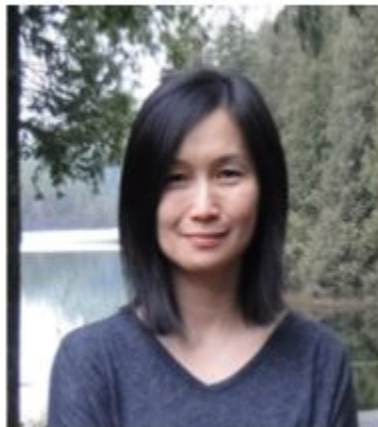
