It Is A **PROMISE**

Peace I leave with you; my peace
I give you. I do not give to you as
the world gives. Do not let your
hearts be troubled and do not be
afraid.

John 14:27

It Transcends UNDERSTANDING

And the peace of God, which
transcends all understanding, will
guard your hearts and your minds
in Christ Jesus.

Philippians 4:7

The peace of God is the supernatural quality that remains calm in the midst of the storm.

3 Reasons people get into storms

- Wrong guidance from the '**experts**'
- Wrong guidance from the '**crowd**'
- Wrong guidance from '**circumstances**'

3 Ways People Respond in Storms

- People will **DRIFT**
- People will **DISCARD**
- People will **DESPAIR**

4 Anchors to Give us confidence in the storm

- Anchor of God's **PRESENCE**
- Anchor of God's **PURPOSE**
- Anchor of God's **PROMISE**
- Anchor of **PRAYER**
