After the service, please join us for fellowship and coffee in the Underwood Room.

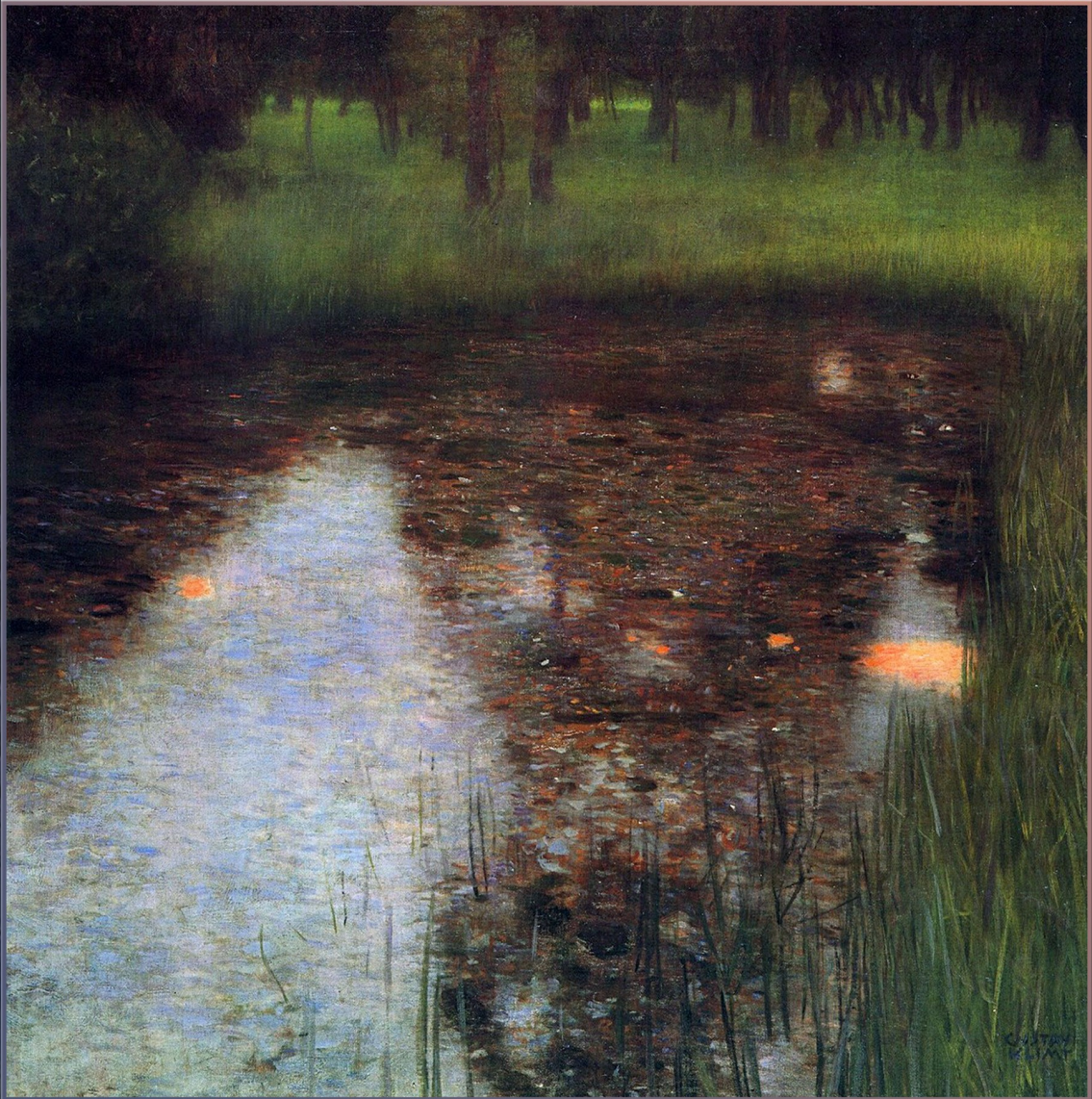


Hospitalization
