

BULLOCK-WEBSTER TRUST GUIDELINES:

Date of Meeting

Grants will be made on the following basis:

1. To those retiring from the Ecclesiastical Province of British Columbia and who have served five years in the Province immediately prior to retirement, or who have served five of the last ten years in the Province. 10/91
2. For whom there is sufficient need to warrant a grant. 10/91
3. Those who retire at or after 65 years of age, or who have forty years of pensionable service, or who are accepted for permanent disability by General Synod Guidelines. 10/91
4. At the discretion of the Trustees, Bullock-Webster Retirement Grants are made on the basis of: 3/91
 - (a) The Capital of the Bullock-webster Trust is to be kept intact and only interest expended.
 - (b) Priority is to be placed on Retirement Grants but Christmas bonuses to be given when funds are available.
 - (c) Retirement Grants are determined by the Trustees at the Fall Meeting of the Provincial House of Bishops.
5. Benefits are available to all eligible clergy in the Ecclesiastical Province of British Columbia.
6. After January 1, 1993, retiring clergy will be invited to apply for assistance through a standard form. 10/92
