



By engaging in hard manual labor Albert's fingers had become stiff and twisted and he could no longer paint. But instead of becoming jealous and bitter, Albert encouraged Albrecht and prayed for his continued success. In fact, one day while Albert was praying Albrecht quietly sketched his brother's gnarled, misshapen hands. Today his masterpiece, The Praying Hands, tells a story of love, sacrifice, and the power of encouragement.
