## A FEELING UNCONTROLLABLE INDIFFERENT

### The Fruit Of Love

It is supernatural love, or agape love. It's a selfless and unconditional commitment to imperfect people. Agape is a love for the utterly unworthy, a love which proceeds from a God who is love.

### THE <u>NECESSITY</u> OF LOVE (1Cor.13:1-3)

If I speak in the tongues<sup>[a]</sup> of men or of angels, but do not have love, <u>I am only a resounding gong or a clanging cymbal</u>. <sup>2</sup> If I have the gift of prophecy and can fathom all mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have a faith that can move mountains, but do not have love, <u>I am nothing</u>. <sup>3</sup> If I give all I possess to the poor and give over my body to hardship that I may boast, <sup>[b]</sup> but do not have love, <u>I gain nothing</u>.

#### THE <u>AUTHENTICITY</u> OF LOVE (1 Cor.13:4-7)

Love is <u>patient</u>, love is <u>kind</u>. It does <u>not envy</u>, it does <u>not boast</u>, it <u>is not proud</u>. <sup>5</sup> It <u>does not dishonor</u> others, it <u>is not self-seeking</u>, it <u>is not easily angered</u>, it <u>keeps no record of wrongs</u>. <sup>6</sup> Love <u>does not delight in evil</u> but <u>rejoices with the truth.</u> <sup>7</sup> It <u>always protects</u>, <u>always trusts</u>, <u>always hopes</u>, <u>always perseveres</u>.

#### THE <u>PERMANENCY</u> OF LOVE(1Cor.13:8-12)

Love never fails. But where there are prophecies, they will cease; where there are tongues, they will be stilled; where there is knowledge, it will pass away. 9 For we know in part and we prophesy in part, <sup>10</sup> but when completeness comes, what is in part disappears. 11 When I was a child, I talked like a child, I thought like a child, I reasoned like a child. When I became a man, I put the ways of childhood behind me. 12 For now we see only a reflection as in a mirror; then we shall see face to face. Now I know in part; then I shall know fully, even as I am fully known.

#### THE SUPREMACY OF LOVE (1Cor.13:13)
