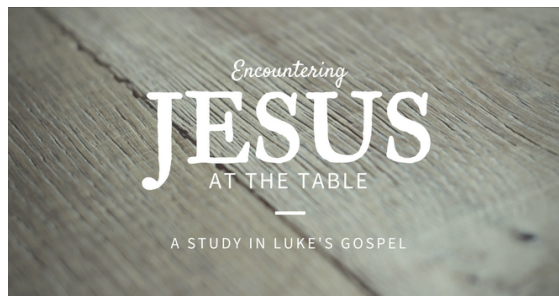

Pray that God gives them direction and multiplies their efforts as they work on prevention by educating families before the girls are ever taken into the sex trade.
