INTRODUCTION: ARE CANADIANS KIND? OR JUST NICE?

Being kind is NOT:

- Being overly nice and cheery all the time.
- Being a push-over.

Recap of chapter one.

1. KINDNESS TAKES THE INITIATIVE

Ruth 2:1-3

Out of faithfulness, Ruth stayed with Naomi. Out of kindness, she took the initiative to provide for her.

Kindness doesn't wait for others to be kind; it takes the initiative.

Matthew 5:46-47

There is no telling what one simple act of kindness will do.

2. KINDNESS IS OFTEN INCONVENIENT

Ruth 2:8-12

Boaz went the "extra mile" with his acts of kindness towards Ruth. Just as Ruth showed faithfulness beyond what could be expected to Naomi, so did Boaz show kindness to Ruth.

God is at work in everyday, simple acts of kindness. And he wants to work through you.

Galatians 5:22-23

3. KINDNESS RESULTS IN KIND

Ruth 2:20-22

Naomi's whole demeanour is transformed by the power of kindness.
