I. I MUST BE <u>RECEPTIVE</u> OF GOD'S WORD. (vs. 19-21)

"... accept the Word planted in you ..." (vs. 21)

ATTITUDES FOR RECEPTION

- Be careful (vs. 19a) "Be quick to listen, slow to speak..."
- Be calm (vs.19b) " ... and slow to become angry ... "
- Be Clean (vs. 21a) "Get rid of all moral filth and the evil that is so prevalent ..."
- Be compliant (vs. 21b) "humbly accept the Word planted in you ..."

2. I MUST *REFLECT* ON GOD'S WORD

- God's word is like a mirror
- I must read it, "... the man who looks intently into the perfect law..."
- I must review it, "... and continues to do so ..."
- I must remember it, "... not forgetting what he has heard ..."

- P Is there a Promise to claim?
- A Is there an Attitude to change?
- C Is there a Command to obey?
- E Is there an Example to follow?
